ORDER APPROVING LIMITED AGENT REGISTRATION

This Order is entered pursuant to the Arkansas Securities Act, codified at Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-42-101 through 23-42-509 (“Act”), the Rules of the Arkansas Securities Commissioner (“Rules”) promulgated under the Act, and the Arkansas Administrative Procedures Act, codified at Ark. Code Ann. §§ 25-15-201-219.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about August 31, 2021, Katie White (“White”) submitted an application to become a registered agent of the issuer for the The Solomon Foundation (“TSF”).
2. White, as an officer, director, or employee of TSF, petitioned the Arkansas Securities Commissioner (“Commissioner”) to waive the Securities Industry Essentials (“SIE”) examination and the appropriate general knowledge or Series 7 examination requirements for her registration as an agent of TSF. White executed an affidavit attesting to the facts in this Order attached hereto as Exhibit A.
3. On or about December 22, 2018, White passed the Series 63 examination.
4. TSF is a religious, not-for-profit organization pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
5. White, as an officer, director, or employee of TSF, performs significant functions for TSF other than effecting or attempting to effect the sale of securities.

6. White represents only TSF in effecting or attempting to effect sales of securities and will offer and sell only securities issued by TSF.
7. White will sell securities only to a limited class of investors in connection with TSF.
8. White will receive no compensation or similar remuneration either directly or indirectly in connection with the offer and sale of TSF securities.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

9. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-42-302(a)(2), the Commissioner may approve a limited agent registration with such limitations, qualifications, or conditions as the Commissioner deems appropriate.
10. In order to be registered as an agent, Rule 302.01(c)(1) of the Rules requires an agent of the issuer to pass the SIE examination, the appropriate general knowledge examination, and the appropriate state law examination.
11. Pursuant to Rule 302.01(c)(6) of the Rules, the Commissioner may waive any or all of the examination requirements required for registration of an agent of the issuer based upon the limited time, amount, or nature of the issue or transaction involved.
12. Based upon the representations made by White, it is appropriate to waive the SIE examination and the appropriate general knowledge or Series 7 examination requirements and approve a limited registration as agent of the issuer.

ORDER

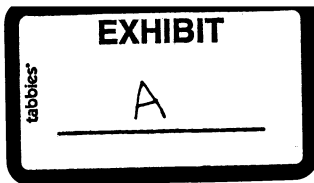
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of White for registration as an agent of the The Solomon Foundation, is hereby approved as a limited registration provided that White only represent the The Solomon Foundation if effecting or attempting to effect sales of

securities and that she is not and will not be compensated in connection with the offer and sale of the The Solomon Foundation securities by the payment of commissions or other remuneration that is based on transactions in securities. The limited registration is effective until December 31, 2021, unless properly renewed.

4. I am an officer, director, or other employee of TSF who performs significant functions for TSF other than effecting or attempting to effect the sale of securities.


5. I represent only TSF in effecting or attempting to effect sales of securities and will offer and sell only securities issued by TSF.

8. I swear and affirm that I know the contents of this affidavit signed by me and that the statements are true and correct.

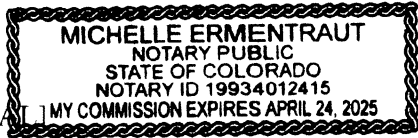
